





## **EXAMINATION CRITERIA**

#### General

The University examination shall be held at the end of each semester as per the prescribed scheme of examination for each discipline and date sheet notified by the University. It will be the responsibility of the candidate to collect all information regarding examination schedule, roll number Slip and resuit etc. from the College office. Students will collect the University Roll Number slips at least one week before the commencement of the examination

The College office displays the schedule of examination/date sheet etc, as soon as it is received from the University on the Notice Board. No candidate will be allowed to appear in the University examination without the Roll Number Slip. The medium of instruction and examination

shall be English.

#### **Examination Fee**

The amount of examination fee Rs. 1100/- paid by a Candidate.

#### Reappear

In case of reappear papers, candidate shall be required to submit their Examination Forms within 15 days from the date of declaration of the result or the regular date to submission of examination forms, which ever is later with the payment of Rs. 1000/-.

#### Attendance In The Classes

As these are regular courses, all the student are required to attend the classes regularly and punctually. They shall become eligible to appear in University Examinations only if they have attended the required no. of lecturer both in theory and practical class.

For University Examinations, a student is required to attend 75 % Of lecturers delivered in theory as well as in Practical classes. A student who has been detained due to shortage of attendance shall not be allowed to sit in the examination and he/she shall required to take readmission in the same semester along with new batch of student with payment of full fee.



#### **Internal Assessment**

The Student of BCA, B.COM & MSc-IT PGDCA Shall be awarded Internal assessment on the basis of the two MSTs Conducted by the College take-home Assignment behavior of the student and class participation etc. There will be 40% assessment in each Paper, (Excluding Projects Reports, Seminars & Practical) The weightage for project Seminars & Practical will be 60 % internal & 40% external evaluation. The passing marks will be Minimum of 40 %.

The Internal Assessment will be based upon the continous evolutions of the student through the MSTs, Class tests, Seminars, Home Assignments and Presence of mind in the class. Any student who Absent From any of the MSTs / Seminars Without the Prior permission of the Director Shall be fined Hs. 100/- Per Paper And shall be deemed to have Scored Zero in Subjects Concerned. Any student found guilty or using unfair means in any Examinations shall be fined Rs. 200/- and shall be awarded zero in paper concerned, besides disciplinary action recommended by the examination Committee. Any student found guilty of misconduct during the examination shall be Severely Punished

#### **Leave Rules**

- \* Student are required to apply for the leave on the prescribed from.
- \* Leave must got sanctioned personally before it is availed of.
- \* In case of illness or in special emergency, leave application must be submitted with in three days of student return to the college.
- \* Reasons & Date of leave must be written clearly
- \* A student who is absent for more than three days without any permission / leave will be detained from the college/

#### **Library Rules**


